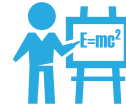

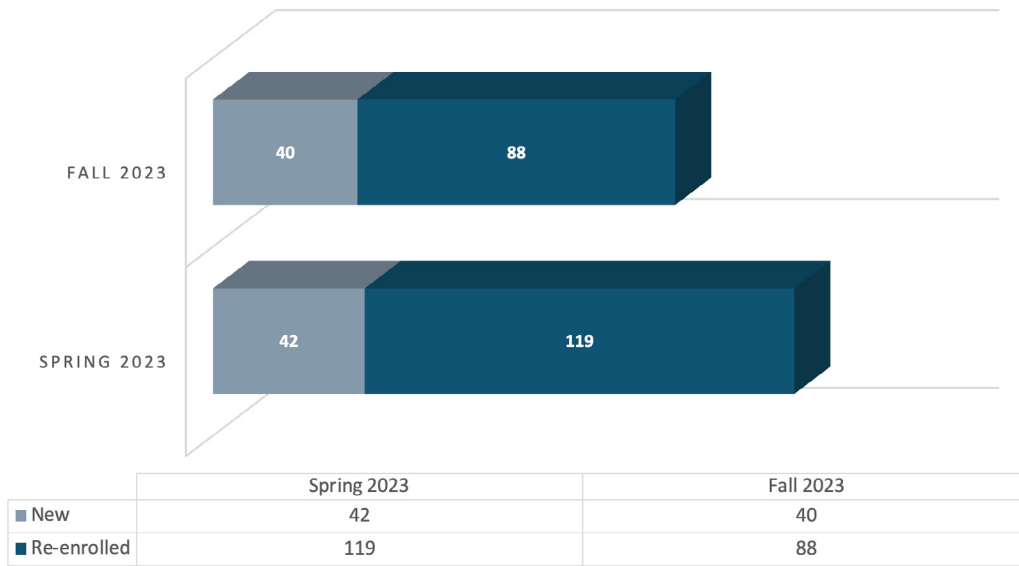

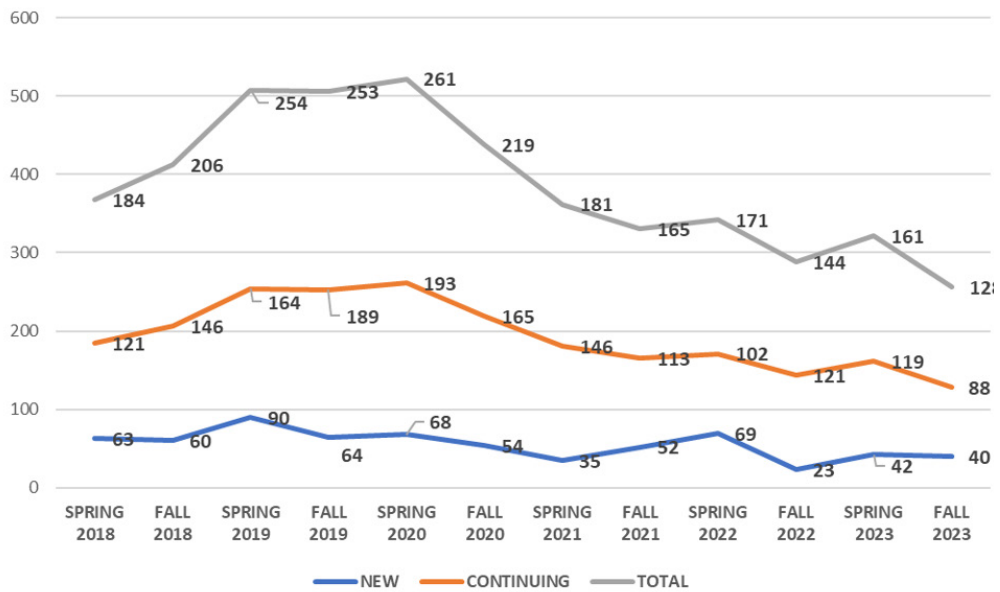

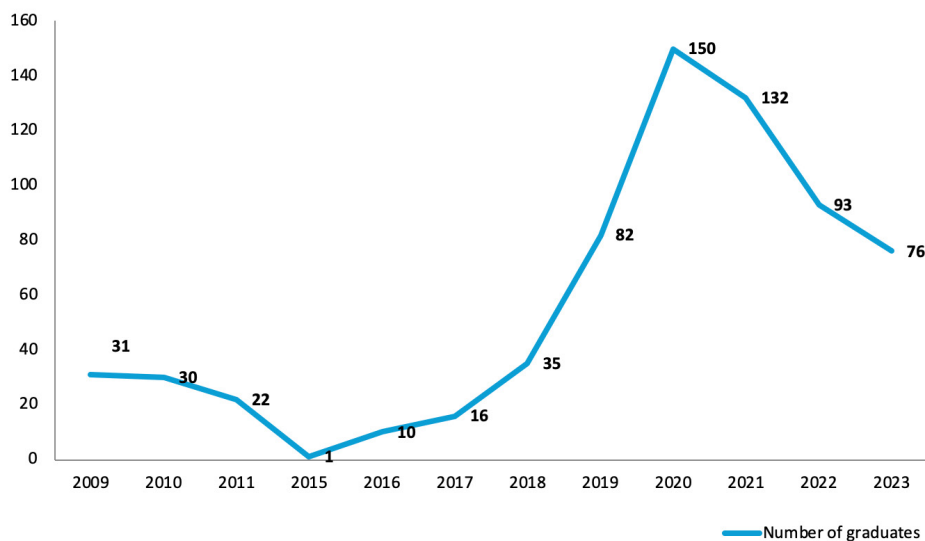

Number of graduates 2009-2023

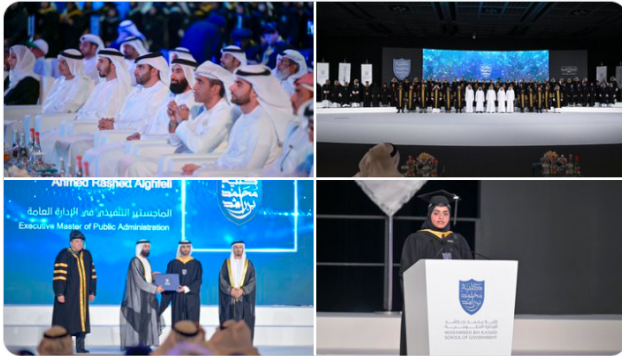

GLOBAL ECONOMIC DIVERSIFICATION INDEX 2023

The Global Economic Diversification Index (GEDI) measures and ranks countries on the extent of their economic diversification from a multi-dimensional angle, exploring diversification of economic activity, international trade as well as of government revenues (away from a dependence on natural resource or commodity revenue). The EDI is based solely on quantitative indicators, with no survey or perception indicators, providing a quantitative benchmark and ranking of the economic diversification of countries, using 25 publicly available indicators, data and information. The 2023 edition of the EDI extends the coverage to a total of 105 countries, for the period 2000 to the Covid19 affected 2020 and 2021.

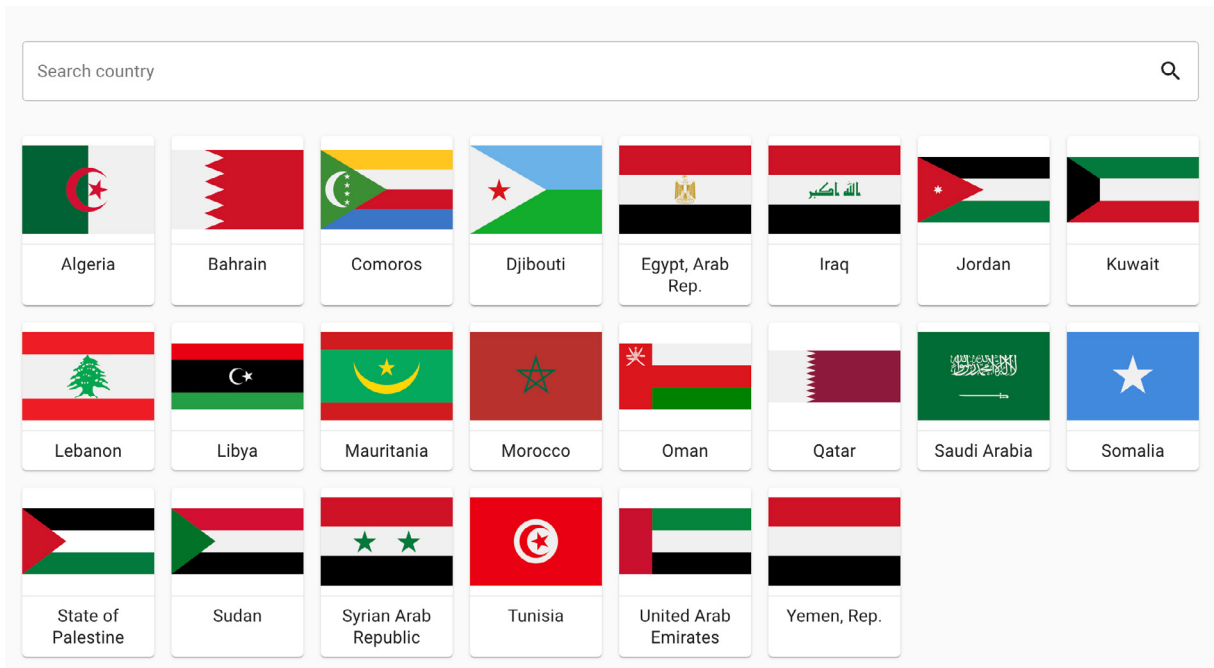
ARAB REGION SDG INDEX 2023

The Arab Region SDG Index and Dashboards 2023 aims to provide a data-driven practical tool for governments, policymakers, and other stakeholders to measure progress on the SDGs, and to highlight implementation challenges and data gaps, as a foundation for actions. The Index comprises of 113 indicators covering the 17 SDGs. Launched at COP 28, this edition of the Arab Index, includes a section dedicated to highlighting findings related to environmental sustainability and climate action.

Policy Council: GPT and Generative AI in Dubai Government

This session, conducted in collaboration with the Dubai Digital Authority and Microsoft, explored the use of generative AI within the Dubai government. It featured the unveiling of a major report on AI's contribution to Dubai's digital economy and included discussions with prominent leaders from Dubai and international corporations.

Workshop on Responsible Generative AI

A collaboration with Digital Dubai and IEEE, this workshop addressed the ethical dimensions of AI deployment across different sectors, guiding participants through AI ethics' complexities at the Dubai Assembly on Generative AI.



Towards Universal Principles for Generative AI in Research and Education

Held at the Dubai Assembly for Generative AI, this policy council session aimed to set universal guidelines for generative AI's application in research and education. Attended by experts and academics, the discussion highlighted the need to address the challenges and opportunities in AI integration, with a strong emphasis on considering the ecosystems that surround generative AI adoption.



Policy Council: Re-imagining Accessibility Rights in the Age of Artificial Intelligence

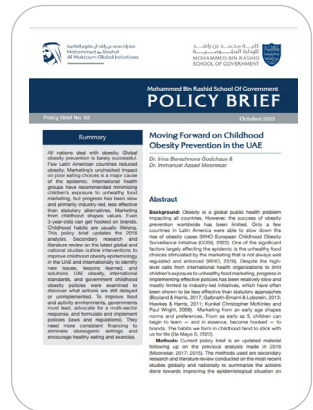

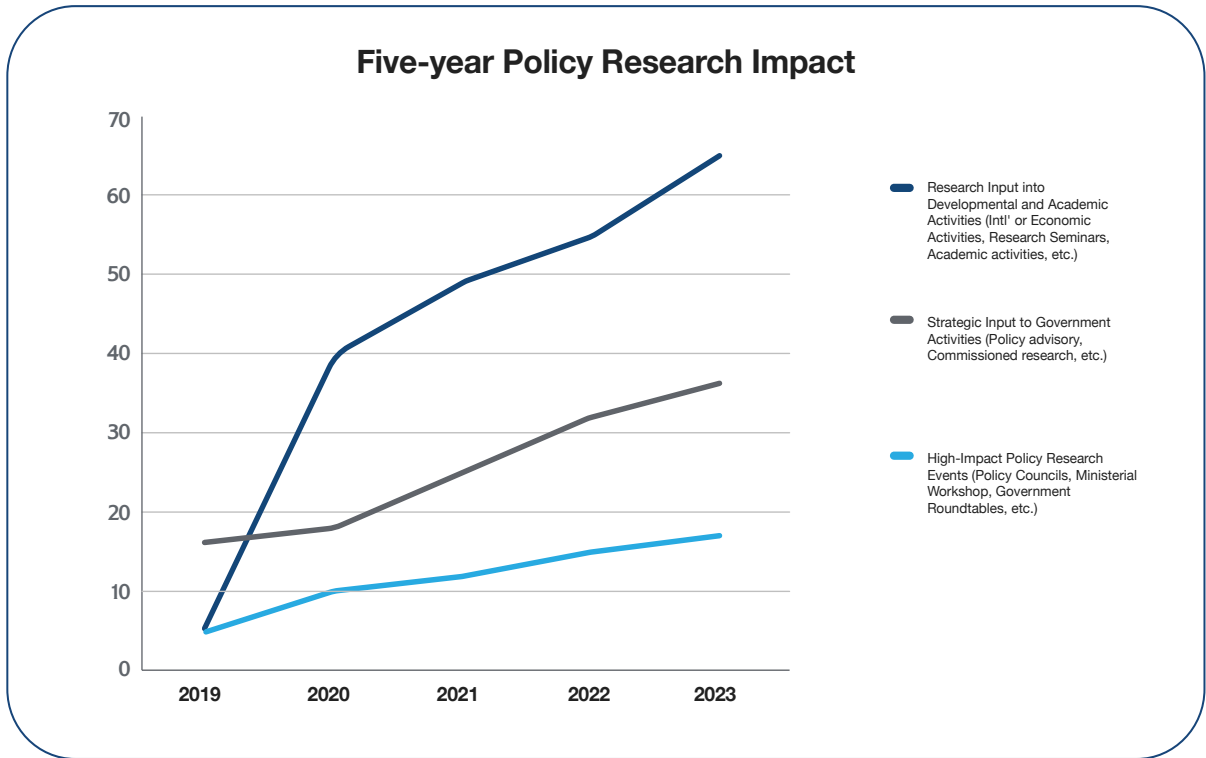

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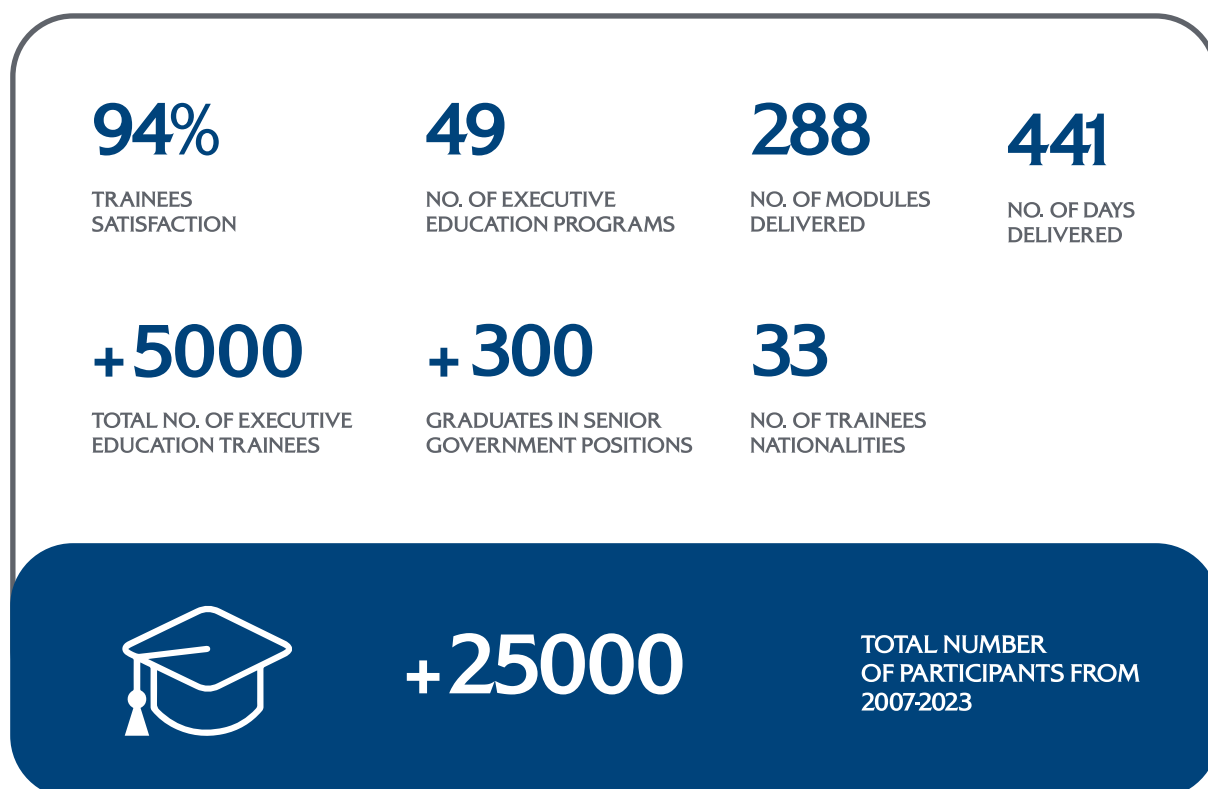

EXECUTIVE EDUCATION

The Mohammed Bin Rashid School of Government (MBRSG) is dedicated to enhancing institutional capabilities within the region through its executive education programs. These programs are meticulously designed to prepare leaders from both the public and private sectors to navigate the complex policy issues that the region faces. Focused and intensive, MBRSG's executive education offerings aim to sharpen the skills of leaders in areas such as public policy, leadership, management, strategic planning, and finance.

In the year 2023, MBRSG successfully completed 49 executive education programs, with 340 trainers playing a key role in their development. These initiatives culminated in the graduation of more than 300 senior government graduates, all of whom are employed across various government bodies in the UAE. This achievement underscores MBRSG's role in advancing the knowledge and capabilities of those at the forefront of governance and policy implementation in the region.

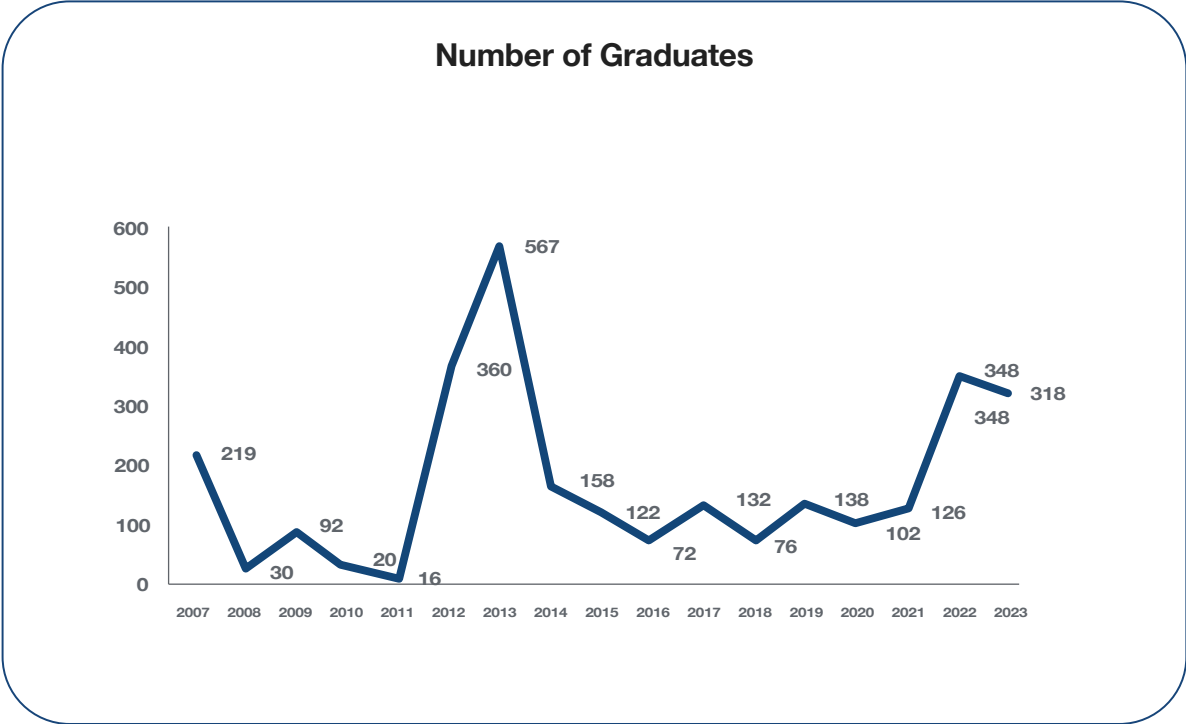
OPEN ENROLLMENT PROGRAMS

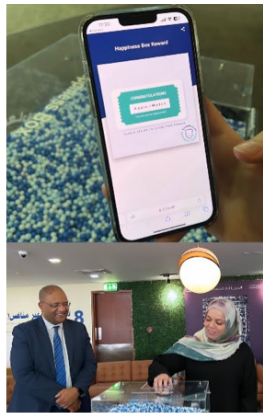
